

## Inclusion Support

**Join our Extended Family...** and make a real and lasting difference for children and young adults with a disability by helping them experience genuine friendship and community inclusion, including in sport, recreation and leisure.

### Who

We are growing our 'family' of engaging and professional support workers who are excellent communicators and passionate about supporting others to access and participate in a range of community based interests.

We want motivated and reliable casual Inclusion Support Workers to work with participants with a disability aged between 4-30 years old and their families.

Ideally you will have past relevant experience and / or minimum Cert III qualification, a current satisfactory Police Check and a current Working with Children Check.

### What

You could be taking someone to their weekly dance class, doing a regular leisure activity with them, helping them learn to use public transport, going to a café and helping them practice their social skills or supporting a group of children to explore a city attraction.

We have roles available to support participants in our:



LinC program (Linking+Inclusion+Community) which offers 'one on one' support to assist children and young people to access the community, skills training to enable participation and support to overcome barriers to access mainstream activities; and



Recreation Programs (groups) which offer opportunities to try new activities in the community, build confidence, skills and friendships

### Where

Current roles are based in the Northern Melbourne Region (Banyule, Nillumbik, Whittlesea, Darebin and Yarra) but may also include travel to other areas of Melbourne.

### When

After school, weekends and school holidays are key times for these roles. Work may occur on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis and shift duration will usually range from 2-6 hours.

Our focus on community participation means you need to be prepared to work outside normal business hours.
