



NDIS Support Coordination

Finding your way through the process of planning and connecting with services can be challenging and time consuming. If you have Support Coordination as part of your NDIS package, we can help you with this process to achieve your goals.

Extended Families Support Coordination services can help you to make sense and take control of your plan / your child's NDIS plan, make choices about the things that are important to you and your child and build your skills and confidence to maximise your NDIS funding.

How will Extended Families Support Coordination services help me with my NDIS plan?

Extended Families provides independent support coordination to help you manage your plan. Our team of experienced staff will help you:

- source and assess support options
- connect with services
- access the NDIS portal
- coordinate services and manage your plan
- respond and deal with any crisis
- build your skills and confidence
- implement and monitor your NDIS plan and re-develop your goals prior to your plan review

Throughout the journey, we aim to empower you to gain independence in creating and maintaining supports.

How much will Support Coordination cost?

Support Coordination is an additional funded item and is not deducted from your direct supports. You must raise and justify the need for Support Coordination in your NDIS assessment planning meeting, with the aim to be allocated a specific and separate budget for this service type (under the support category 'Capacity Building').

How do I receive the Extended Families Support Coordination service?

Talk to your NDIA Planner and discuss what level of Coordination of Support to include in your plan. Once you have this in your plan, your Support Planner or Local Area Coordinator (LAC) will generally send Extended Families a service request, along with a copy of your plan; or a service request can be made via your NDIS portal with the help of your planner, LAC or friend. Once we receive the service request and a copy of your plan, our staff will contact you and arrange an initial meeting and develop a service agreement.

- Supported play groups, friendship groups and social events
